**NOTICE INVITING INTERESTED CONTRACTORS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025/26
CALIFORNIA UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING (CUPCCA) PROGRAM
INFORMAL BID LIST FOR
CALAVERAS COUNTY**

In accordance with the State of California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission, the County is inviting all interested licensed contractors to submit their company information for inclusion on the County's Pre-Qualified Bidding Contractors List for construction projects under \$75,000 and up to \$220,000 (Informal Bid) during the 2025 fiscal year. Per California Public Contract Code, Section 22032, any Public Project that is estimated to be below the current threshold limits of \$220,000 is subject to the Field Contract or Informal Bidding Procedures set forth by the State of California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission. All trade categories are subject to Informal Bidding Procedures. Contractors that are interested in being on the 2025/26 Informal Bidding Contractors List are required to have a current license, subject to verification through the Contractors State License Board, and be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations as per SB 854.

Contractor Insurance. The Contractor shall obtain and maintain the following insurance coverages with minimum coverage amounts as set forth in the table below:

Commercial General Liability Including: 1. Products and completed operations 2. Property damage, 3. Bodily injury; and 4. Personal & advertising injury	Per Occurrence: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) Aggregate: Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000)
Automobile Liability	Per Accident: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) for bodily injury and property damage.
Workers Compensation	Per Claim: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) in accordance to the laws of the State of California
Professional Liability	Per Occurrence: One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) Aggregate: Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000)

As required (per job):

The insurance policies are to contain the following provision.

Additional Insured Status: The County, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds on the CGL policy with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of the Contractor including materials, parts, or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations.
